<u>REGISTRATION FEE</u>: \$10.00 per veteran attending. This is to cover miscellaneous and incidental costs in preparing for this reunion.

<u>HOUSING</u>: *On-Post* - Bldg 5678, Allin Hall (formerly the Hi-Rise BOQ). You will need to book your own reservation by MAY 1ST as shown on the Registration Form. This facility is now operated by a civilian contractor, Holiday Inn Express (IHG hotels). *Off-Post-* On your own

Jerry advises that the \$65.00/night is a very good rate and includes a generous breakfast.

TRANSPORTATION: If you are driving to Ft Sill, you're all set. If you are flying, Jerry suggests you check the cost differential between landing in OKC rather than Lawton directly. Some airlines jack up prices for regional landings. You may save (or not). Should you choose the Lawton Airport, Jerry advises that the typical cab fare to the post or town averages \$10.00 with the typical "added person" rates. Suggest "Busy Bee" cab service.

<u>POST TRANSPORTATION</u>: The post shuttle runs hourly (8am – 10pm) and has a stop at Bldg 5678; this may be of interest to guest and dependents to explore Ft Sill in lieu of other activities. *Jerry has arranged busses for our field trips (provided by Ft Sill)*

<u>CAR RENTAL</u>: For those in need of a rental car, Jerry has a special arrangement with the downtown Lawton Enterprise Car Rental office as shown on the Registration Form. Sorry, offer valid only at the Lawton office.

MEALS: The first event, Wednesday evening, will be the "ice-breaker" at the Lawton Country Club. Time is 6:30pm. The cost is \$22/person for "heavy Hors D'oeuvres"; Jerry advises this will be a meal equivalent. All bars are "cash bars". All lunches are "on your own". Mess Hall menus vary (as always) and prices are under \$10/person. Thursday Dinner is "on your own", but we may get a consensus as to "where" if we go as a group. Open to suggestions. Wednesday Night: Ice Breaker Cocktail Party; Lawton Country Club; Time 6:30pm

<u>Thursday:</u> Visit to the enlisted basic training area (1st Bn, 19th Field Artillery) in the AM. For those who did their basic training here it will be an "eye opener" to see how basic training has changed and is conducted. They have nice living areas and Chow Halls, but tough physical and mental training. The DI's are most impressive. They are producing well-trained soldiers. Afternoon will be with the 1st Battalion 78th Field Artillery to see a variety of cannons, to include the 155mm SP Paladin, and the HIMARS Free flight Rocket system.
